DFA is aware of the concerns of its customers surrounding the marketing of milk derived from cloned cows and their progeny. DFA will continue to monitor the activities of the Food and Drug Administration ("FDA") as well as the general situation in the dairy industry for its members and customers. On December 6, 2006, DFA's Board of Directors ("Board") held a discussion regarding what position, if any, DFA should currently take with regard to the marketing of milk from cloned cows or from their progeny. The Board thereafter approved the following resolution, which is subject to review and modification within the Board's discretion:

DFA will not knowingly market milk from cloned cows or their progeny.

DFA is committed to providing its customers with dairy products that are safe for human consumption and fully comply with all applicable governmental regulations, including DFA's guaranty that all milk marketed by DFA and all products manufactured by DFA are not adulterated or misbranded within the meaning of the United States Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetics Act.
